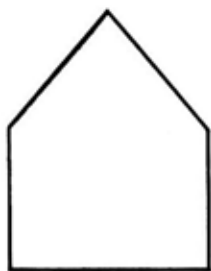
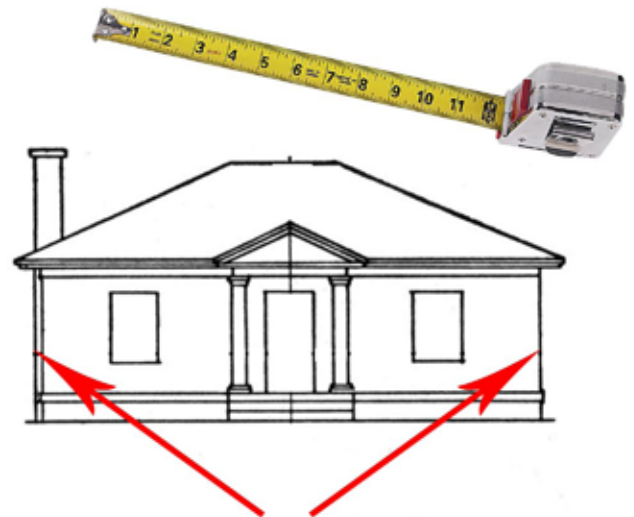


This guide is to help you measure your property, what you must remember, the more accurate you are, the more accurate the price will be.

If you over estimate the price will be higher than the actual price which will be better for you as the price will be reduced on survey.

Method 1

With a tape measure, measure in metres the length of brickwork for runs that are not gable ends.



For Gable Ends

Measure brickwork and multiply by 1.5

example: $8 \times 1.5 = 12$ metres

Total up and enter into our online quote system.

Method 2

Without a tape measure - Normally guttering is installed with the gutter brackets 1metre apart, so count the metres using the brackets as a guide. On gable ends, most are 10 metres in total, but you can count the tiles (3 tiles = 1metre approx).

Method 3

Email us digital photo's of all views of your property and with our computer software we can work out your measurements for you and email a price back to you. When taking photo's please be sure to stand far enough back to try and get the ground conditions in aswell (this is for access purposes).

Method 4
